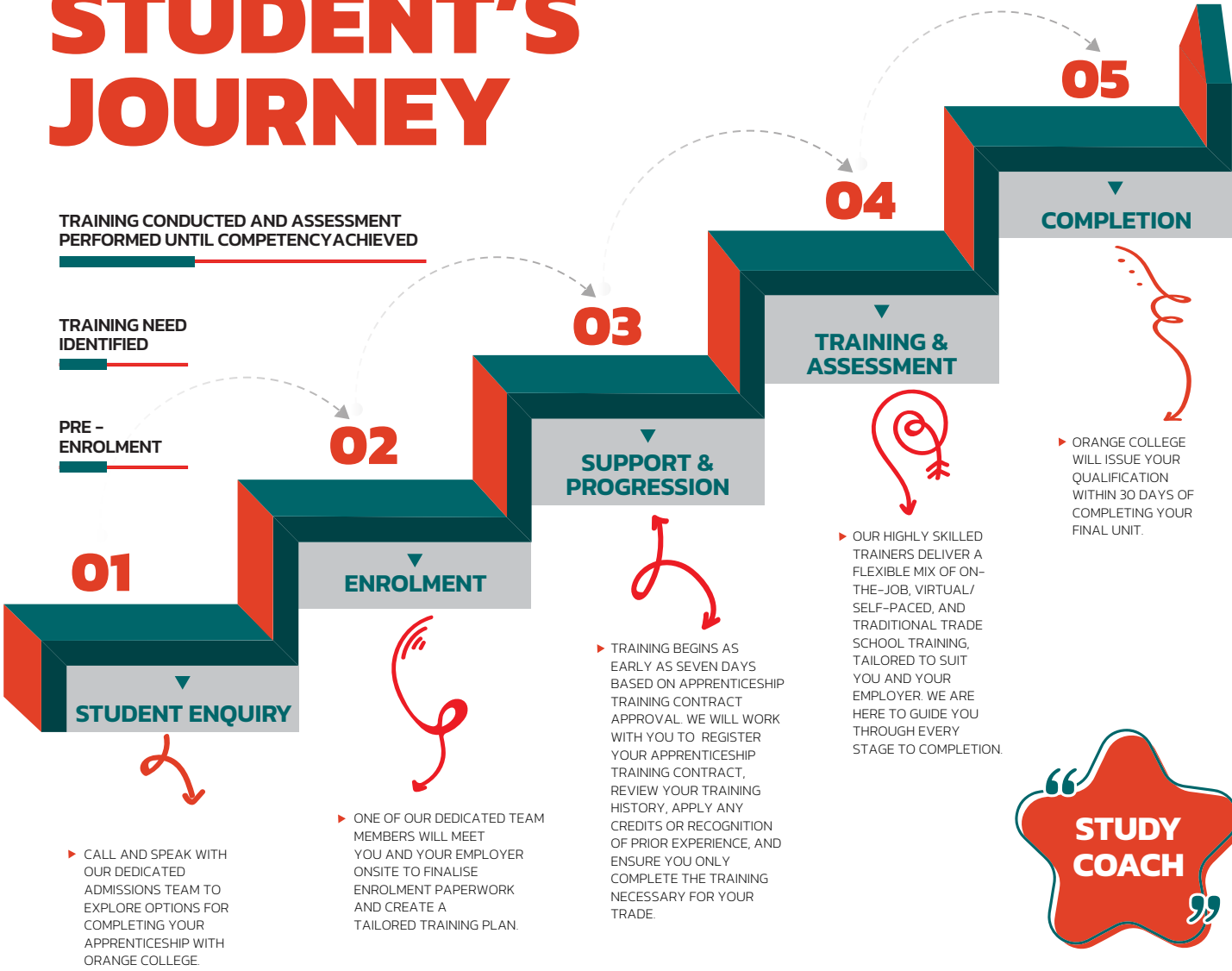
The trainer and student will review any pending coursework and adjust the training plan accordingly by scheduling extra training/facilitation sessions as needed.
